- ▶ **Tournament Entry form is due by July 3<sup>rd</sup> entry/drop deadline** (fees still due if drop after 7/3) – payment must be received no later than July 10<sup>th</sup>
  - ▶ **Tournament Brackets will be posted on website by Friday, July 10<sup>th</sup> by 5 pm**
  - ▶ **District round (8U, 10U & 12U) — Re-scheduled to July 22-27**
  - ▶ **State Championship round — July 30-August 3** (for all age groups if enough entries)
  - ▶ **No Semi-State round this year**
  - ▶ **3<sup>rd</sup> Annual 14U Open Tournament — July 22-27**

- **Host sites will be released only when finalized. No brackets will be released prior to website posting.**
- **Please send tournament entry fee w/ your entry form. Fee must be paid before team can play.**
- *League Sanction fee is waived this year* – All entrants will receive the same tournament entry fee. If a sanction fee has already been paid, we can apply it toward your tourney entry fee, return it or shred by request.
- All teams entered must be from your league, town, or your school's kids. Any exception must be approved by us.
