

# 2020 Town & Country League Tournament Update

as of 7/10/20

We are moving forward with the scheduled State Tournament with the updated brackets now available on our website. Of course, our plans are subject to change as directives from State health & safety organizations dictate.

Here are the key updates:

## ► **BASEBALL: Tournament Entry form is due by July 3<sup>rd</sup> entry/drop deadline**

- 8U – at Mentone - July 31 – August 2 - one round only
- 10U District I – at Plymouth - July 25 – 26
- 10U District II – at Fairmount (Madison-Grant) - July 25 – 26
- 10U Finals – at Denver (North Miami) - July 31 – August 2
- 12U District I – at Denver (North Miami) - July 25 – 26
- 12U District II – at Gas City (Mississinewa) - July 25 – 26
- 12U Finals – at Fairmount (Madison-Grant) - July 31 – August 2
- 14U Open Tournament — Cancelled due to lack of entries
- No Semi-State round this year
- *League Sanction fee is waived this year.* All entrants will receive the same tournament entry fee. If the sanction fee has already been paid, we will apply it toward your league's tourney entry fee, return it to you or shred by request. No checks received have been cashed yet.

## ► **SOFTBALL: Tournament Entry form is due by July 3<sup>rd</sup> entry/drop deadline**

- 8U – Cancelled due to lack of entries
- 10U - at Denver (North Miami) - July 25 – 26 - one round only (4 entrants)
- 12U – Cancelled due to lack of entries
- 14U – Cancelled due to lack of entries
- *No Sanction fees.* All entrants will receive the same tournament entry fee, but we must have enough entrants to coordinate this event.

## **Tournament info for BOTH Baseball & Softball:**

- ALL teams entered must be from your league, town, or your school's kids. If your league cancelled its regular season, but still wants to enter a team(s) in the State tournament, it will be permitted as long as the team is comprised from kids from your normal league, town or school. Any exception must be approved by Town & Country League Office.
- We strongly recommend taking all precautions as advised in all Governor & Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines. Any additional Host site guidelines will also be adhered to.
