- **Tourney Brackets will be posted on website by Friday, June 30**
- **8U & 10U** – may start as early as Thursday, July 13 thru Monday, July 17
- **12U & 14U** – may start as early as Thursday, July 20 thru Monday July 24

NOTES: All posted tourney dates are weather-permitting & subject to change, including extending if necessary.

- **Sending tournament entry fee w/ your entry form is preferred & must be paid before team can play.**
- All teams entered must be from your league, town, or your school's kids. We must approve any exception.
