Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

- Roster forms, tournament brackets & contact #'s are all available on our website (see below)
- Tournament entry fee must be paid before team is allowed to play. Entry fee is paid directly to Town & Country Youth League, PO Box 75, Delphi, IN 46923. It is not to be paid to host at checkin.
- Roster form must be completed in advance & all players must be listed to be eligible to play
- Host sites are allowed to charge fans either a 'team gate fee', admission fee or parking fee to help offset costs of umpires (see tournament Host Site within rules for guidelines). Please prepare your fans so they are not surprised upon arrival. Here are the sites for this yr:
- <u>8U at Oak Hill</u> will be charging a \$100 team gate fee per team upon arrival, but no additional entry or parking fees will be charged
- <u>10U at Upland</u> will be charging an entry or parking fee not to exceed Town & Country posted guidelines for entrance into the park, but no additional 'team gate fee'
- <u>12U at Denver</u> will be charging a \$100 team gate fee per team upon arrival, but no additional entry or parking fees will be charged

Upon arrival to Host site:

- Check-in with host site's designated person & submit your team's roster form & birth certificates (copies are preferred)
- Host site will keep your roster form & return birth certificates to you

Tournament Reminders:

- Please use the 'Protest & Rules Committee" procedures as noted on the tournament rules page
 for handling any disputes that arise during a game. Contacting league officials not present will
 only result in lengthy game delays in order to make an informed decision. In no event will an
 umpire judgment decision be overruled.
- All game times & dates are subject to change due to weather conditions, including extending
 the tournament if needed. In such event, efforts will be made to reschedule games as promptly
 & in as fair of manner possible in order to complete the tournament. Such efforts may include
 adding game time limits, cancelling loser bracket games & using single elimination, if needed.
 Every effort will be made to play to each games entirety.
- Host sites are responsible for rescheduling all games that have been postponed for any reason.
 - O To help offset costs, we provide 1st & 2nd place trophies, at least 2 doz. game balls & metal signs for all winning teams & Finals runner-up teams. Host sites will hire & pay umpires & will keep all concession proceeds, as well as income from any other source including t-shirt sales, sponsorships, etc. Please encourage your fans to visit the concession stand as a way to support a host site in covering expenses.
