We recommended emailing form, then mail payment. Payment must be received by July 1st.

- **Tourney Brackets will be posted on website by Friday, June 21**
- **8U & 10U** – may start as early as Tuesday, July 9 thru Monday, July 15
- **12U & 14U** – may start as early as Tuesday, July 16 thru Monday July 22

NOTES: All posted tourney dates are weather-permitting & subject to change, including extending if necessary.

- All tournament information will be posted on the website. **However, we ask that each league please provide the one preferred address below for other tournament correspondence** (roster forms, rule books, etc). **We will mail to the best address listed on this form to then be distributed to each team entered from your league.**
- **Host sites will be released only when finalized. Also, no brackets will be released prior to website posting.**
- We ask for your patience while we work to finalize host sites. No host sites will be released until all are confirmed.
- **This close to deadline, we recommended emailing form, then mail payment.** Fee must be paid before team can play.
- All teams entered must be from your league, town, or your school's kids. We must approve any exception.
