## 56<sup>th</sup> annual STATE TOURNAMENT ENTRY form

**IMPORTANT DATES:** ► **Tournament Entry form is due by June 7 deadline** (fees still due if team drops after 6-9)  
**We recommended emailing form, then mail payment.** Payment must be received by July 1st.

- Tourney Brackets will be posted on website by Fri., June 21
- District round (8, 10 & 12U) – July 2-8 (Note: No games will be played on July 4)
- Semi-State round (8, 10 & 12U)– July 10-15
- State Championship round (8, 10 & 12U)– July 18-22
- 6<sup>th</sup> Annual 14U Open Tournament – July 9-14 / July 16-21 (depending on entries)

**NOTES:** All posted tourney dates are weather-permitting & subject to change, including extending if necessary.

- All tournament information will be posted on the website. **However, we ask that each league please provide the one preferred address below for other tournament correspondence** (mail, roster forms, rule books, etc.)
- **Host sites will be released only when finalized.** No host sites will be released until all are confirmed.
- **This close to deadline, we recommended emailing form, then mail payment.** Fee must be paid before team can play.
- All teams entered must be from your league, town, or your school's kids. We must approve any exception.
- This is a Rec League All-Star tournament. Playing travel is allowed, but players & teams must still be from Rec League.
- The annual League Sanction fee was due in the League office by May 15<sup>th</sup> for tournament entry discount rate.
- Each participating team will pay a \$100 team gate fee to help pay for umpires at each District host site. The advancement fee for both the Semi-State & State Finals rounds will be \$150 / team. District sites will also receive a stipend check from the league. No additional entry or parking fees will be charged at any District host site.
